Second VP shop report for June meeting:

Sorry I will miss another meeting, but for the week of 19<sup>th</sup> to the 27<sup>th</sup> of June, I am out of town.

## Shop:

Saws 2, 5, 10 still out of commission until we get all the parts and some shop time. Both current shop volunteers, Clyde Smith and Norm Burge, have other obligations. I am out of town and my last shop session, Thu. June 16 was largely occupied with rebuilding air pumps on Genies 2, 3, 4. I will be back the 29<sup>th</sup> or 30<sup>th</sup>.

I am just going to take the 1 hp motor for saw 10 into an electric motor shop for diagnosis – we haven't been able to resolve it and have not yet approached "Makers' Space" with a proposal to have their members help us repair motors. I want to expedite its repair and get it back into action.

Besides just a spring cleaning, the cleaning day was about setting a precedent in the hopes that folks would be inspired by a cleaner space to help keep it clean. That has worked to some extent, and I really want to acknowledge whoever has been cleaning up the sink area – it is really appreciated. And thanks to those who do their part at the end of a shop session to refill jugs, clean their equipment, empty buckets, and assist the supervisors with trash, clean-up, or supporting others in doing their part.

Found on June 16<sup>th</sup>, Saw 6, Big Greenie, the 14" Highland Park, was left again with thick layers of reddish crud on all the horizontal surfaces except the front landing platform. The carriage, ledges, and back landing were again left thickly coated and no effort was made to clean them.

To the person(s) doing this, both incidences were found on a Thursday, so it is occurring on either Saturdays or Mondays. This blatant lack of shop courtesy is disappointing at the least and creates more work forshop volunteers or sticks the next person to use that saw with a bigger mess to clean up than they made.
